

ARTICLE 7


For the sake of further development of tourism, the Parties shall promote reciprocal visits of experts in this field.

ARTICLE 8

This Agreement shall enter into force on the day of signature. This Agreement is concluded for an indefinite period of time, and may be terminated by either Party by a written notification sent by diplomatic channels. The Agreement shall terminate six months after the delivery of the written notification to the other Party.

Done in *Amman* on *9/13/08* In two original copies in Arabic, Czech, and English languages, all of these language versions being equally authentic. In case of difference in the interpretation, the English version shall prevail.

The Ministry of Tourism and Antiquities of the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan and the Ministry for Regional Development of the Czech Republic (hereinafter referred to as the "Parties") wishing to further expand friendly relations between the two countries based on equality and developing the tourism relations between the two countries,

HAVE AGREED AS FOLLOWS:

ARTICLE 1

The Parties shall take all the necessary steps towards promotion and support of tourism between the two countries and shall promote reciprocal activities carried on by tourist bureaus and other institutions and organizations involved in tourism.

ARTICLE 2

The Parties shall consider possible methods of promotion of investment in tourism within the limits of law applicable in their respective countries.

ARTICLE 3

The Parties shall exchange tourism – related information and statistics published in both countries, shall promote mutual participation of subjects involved in tourism in specialized trade fairs and shall cooperate in other international events organized in the field of tourism.

ARTICLE 4

The Parties shall promote, in particular, incoming tourism to tourist destinations of their respective countries.

ARTICLE 5

The Parties shall seek possibilities of further development and strengthening technical cooperation, particularly in respect of professional training.

ARTICLE 6

The Parties shall exchange experiences and information relating to the methods of realization of tourism in their respective countries.
